To the Applicant

The criteria used to select the recipients of the MHS Alumni Association or the W.A. Strouse Margarettta Alumni Scholarships are:

- you must be a graduating senior of MHS
  - you must be in good standing with at least a 2.8 grade point average
  - you must provide proof of acceptance to a trade school, college, or university
1. Follow the MHS Alumni Association link on Margarettta website at [www.margarettta.k12.0h.us](http://www.margarettta.k12.0h.us). to obtain this scholarship application and the "Permission to Release Records" form electronically.
  2. Email your completed application and essay as attachments directly to the MHS Scholarship Committee Chair, Jean Smith, at [jeanbwt@aol.com](mailto:jeanbwt@aol.com). Applications must be received by **May 13th** in order to be considered.
  3. Submit a copy of your proof of acceptance and the signed "Permission to Release Records" form to the Guidance Office of Margarettta High School by **May 13th**. Also arrange for an official high school transcript with the Guidance Office.
  4. The Guidance Office will turn over your transcript, proof of acceptance, and "Permission to Release Records" form to the MHS Alumni Scholarship Committee for review.
  5. Recipients of the scholarships will be notified at graduation.
  6. Upon mailing a copy of your registration payment to your trade school, college, or university to the MHS Alumni Association, PO Box 29, Castalia, OH, 44824, your scholarship award will be mailed to you in the form of a check.
